Whether it by family or friends. Each and everyone of us has had our life touched by a veteran. Last year President Susan joined the FL JCI Senate placing wreaths at the Bushnell National Cemetery. She was very moved with the program and has asked that it be made available to every U. S. Senator to participate in. Please go to their website www.wreathsacrossamerica.org to see many ways for you to help. You can sponsor a wreath at \$15.00 per wreath that will be placed on a veteran's grave marker. You can volunteer to help place wreaths at a National or local cemetery. The United States is broken down into regions and on their website, you can find your regional representative who can give you further information. The Date this year is December 17<sup>th</sup>. Please consider assisting in this program you will be glad you did.

This program was started by Morrill Worcester owner of Worcester Wreath Company of Harrington Maine. In 1992 Worcester Wreath Company found themselves with a surplus of wreaths. Remembering his childhood experience visiting Arlington Cemetery, he now had the opportunity to honor our veterans. With the aid of former Senator Olympia Snowe arrangement were made for the placement of the wreaths. This was done until 2005 when a photo of the stones at Arlington, adorned with wreaths and snow circulated on the web. Suddenly, the program received national attention. Fast forward to 2021, Wreaths Across America and its national network of volunteers placed 2.4 million veteran wreaths at 3,137 participating cemeteries'.

And the best news....ASAC will NOT increase the registration fee as previously stated. So, you can still get this great deal!!!!!



#### In Memoriam

#### February 7, 1933 – July 22, 2022

Jim O'Connell #5046 was elected Charter President of the newly formed US JCI Senate on June 20, 1972, at the first meeting of the newly formed organization, and he served from 1972-1973. It was at this time, through the efforts of Jim and other "pioneers" of our organization, that the group came together, sought, and received official recognition from the US Jaycees. Jim was instrumental in laying the groundwork for our present national Senate organization. Jim also served as the first President of the Illinois JCI Senate and was a member of the Illinois Jaycees Hall of Fame. He was a friend and mentor to countless Jaycees and Senators over the years. His leadership has influenced our organization for the past 50 years.

Jim not only impacted the US JCI Senate, but he also had many other civic and business affiliations throughout his lifetime, including service on numerous boards and committees. He lived a life rooted in our belief "that service to humanity is the best work of life."

## History of the Day

On Aug. 1, 1972, Nate Colbert of the San Diego Padres set a Major League record by driving in 12 runs during a doubleheader sweep of the Atlanta Braves. The slugging first baseman broke the record of 11 RBIs in a twinbill -- a mark shared by Earl Averill of the Cleveland Indians, Jim Tabor of the Boston Red Sox and Boog Powell of the Baltimore Orioles. The 26-year-old Colbert also set a record with 22 total bases and tied a Major League record by clubbing five home runs in the twinbill. As Colbert rounded the bases after hitting his fifth home run against the Braves, he commented to umpire Bruce Froemming: "I don't believe it." Froemming responded in agreement, "I don't either." Colbert, whose lifted his seasonal home run total to 27, would finish the year with a career-high 38 home runs and 111 RBIs.
