We have a form letter for you to send to the mass mail provider if your email address has been "Blacklisted" because of too many bounces. Once you are moved to that list by the list server this letter, requesting to be taken off the "blacklist," is the only option, resubscribing will not solve the problem.

If you are an aol or yahoo user (as I am) you may need to contact your email provider for suggestions. We are trying with this issue to see if the efforts made by the mass mail provider on our behalf have been successful. More on that later.
