National Convention 2022 - Louisville KY

The Louisville 2022 Convention Planning Committee is working hard and we are looking forward to welcoming you to Louisville KY and southern Indiana in June 2022! We strongly suggest that you check out our website: <u>https://celebratefriends2022.wixsite.com/website</u>. It is packed full of information and is very user friendly, and it makes registering for all convention related matters very easy.

The host hotel is the Crowne Plaza Airport Louisville KY. The booking link can be found on the aforementioned website. When you go to Hotel Reservations, it defaults to the dates of June 26-July 1, 2022, however if you wish to stay a couple more days after the convention, you can change the dates and the same room rate will apply until July 3rd.

The Crown has a tropical indoor/outdoor pool as well as the Blue Horse Restaurant and Bar which features a fully stocked Bluegrass Bourbon Bar; an all-day menu of their own distinctive Kentucky cuisine, an extensive breakfast buffet and inviting outdoor seating. They are also part of the Urban Bourbon Trail.

At this time the Crowne Plaza **DOES NOT** have any available rooms before our event on **June 24th and June 25th**, so the overflow hotel is the Galt House in downtown Louisville. When you call the Crowne and ask to book a room on June 25th, they will tell you that no rooms are available; however you can go ahead and make your reservation starting on June 26th.

You can call and book a room in our block at the Galt House at 502-589-5200 or <u>www.galthouse.com</u> and use our **Group Code USJ0624** or you can go to our website and find the booking link there. The legendary Galt House hotel is only 6 miles from the Crowne. These rooms are also at the same rate of \$145.00 which is a 50% discount price for this historical hotel. The parking fee has been waived for our group and there are 2 great

restaurants, Walkers Exchange and Swizzle which is a retro-style supper club for the modern diner and Jockey Silks Bourbon bar in the hotel. Also you are within walking distance of many other restaurants and sites in downtown Louisville such as 4th Street Live; the Muhammad Ali Center and Whiskey & Museum Rows.
